ORDINANCE NO. 168

SUBJECT:

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE YEAR 1998-99". THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD ORDAINS:

- Section 1. That the Annual City Budget for the Fiscal Year 1998-99 be adopted.
- Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Wakefield, Michigan, hereby makes provision for an appropriation to the several funds hereinafter named, the several amounts as set forth in said Budget and as required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the corporation for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1999 payable from the several funds and from any other fund created by the law as follows:

Section 3. That the following respective sums shall be raised by taxation with the next general levy:

GENERAL OPERATING (INCLUDING LIBRARY).....	\$ 260,148
GARBAGE.....	0
SEWER BOND AND INTEREST.....	0
TOTAL AMOUNT TO BE RAISED BY TAXES.....	\$ 260,148

Section 4. That there be appropriated and it is hereby ordered that there may be raised by taxation with the next general and special City tax levy in the City of Wakefield, Michigan, to be paid into the several established funds of said City for the purpose of defraying the expenditures and liabilities for the 1998-99 Fiscal Year, as estimated and determined by the City Council of said City for the objects and purpose hereinafter set forth and in addition to the anticipated receipts and revenues of said City from other sources in the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand One Hundred Forty Eight Dollars the particular objects and purposes for which said sum is hereby ordered to be raised being based on several objects set forth in the Annual City Budget, published in the Wakefield News on June 4, 1998 and amended at the budget meeting are as follows:
